Property Tax

Property taxes fund Education, the County of Peterborough and the Township. For residential ratepayers, the taxes paid to the Township are shared as follows:

County 32% Township 51%

Please note that a 1.25% penalty is imposed on unpaid balances on the 1st day of each and every month the default continues. Township Staff do not have the authority to waive penalties.

Flat rates for Area Services on the Tax Bill

Annual Rate for:

- Curbside Pick Up (island and vacant lands excluded) \$53.00 per household and/or unit
- * For owners of properties served by the Municipal Water Systems in Keene and Stewart Hall \$2,244.00 per household
- For Burnham Meadow property owners served by sewer systems: \$1,139.00 per household and/or unit
- * Swimming Pool Surcharge \$114.00 per household in Keene and Stewart Hall
- * Street Light Service Areas are rated by community area

Payments

Pre-authorized payment plans are available. If paying through internet banking, please allow 2-3 business days for us to receive payment to ensure your payment is not received late. You can also pay by credit card online through Paymentus.

Property Tax Grant for low-income seniors and persons with disabilities If you are a senior on the guaranteed income supplement or a person on a disability pension, you may qualify for a property tax grant. This grant covers permanent year round residences only. The County of Peterborough runs the program and it is administered by the Township. Proof of eligibility is required. Applications will be available on our website and in the office by approximately the end of September and must be submitted by November 15, 2023.

Budget 2023

The 2023 Total Township Budget is \$14,588,847 which includes operating costs of \$7,926,176, capital plan projects of \$4,918,199 and \$1,744,472 provision for reserves to fund future infrastructure replacement. The 2023 Total Township Tax Levy is \$6,859,186 with the balance funded through grants, user fees, development charges, reserve transfers and other revenue.

This translates into a 2.79% increase in the Township tax rate. Each property is impacted differently based on the assessed value determined by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation. Assessment increases are generally phased in over four years. For more information about assessment, please check out the MPAC website at www.mpac.ca. Building Department

When considering a renovation, alteration, addition, new build, swimming pool and adding a secondary suite please call the Building Department at 705-295-6852 ext 233 to discuss the details of your project. We can answer any questions that would relate to applying for a building/renovation permit, help with the requirements for drawings, zoning, septic systems setbacks and Otonabee Conservation approval.

Building permits are required for the following:

- Additions, renovation, or alteration to a house, adding a secondary suite
- New industrial, commercial, and institutional buildings
- Making new openings
- Swimming pool
- Decks, fireplaces, adding plumbing fixtures, finishing a basement
- Tents greater than 60 sq m (646 sq.ft.) in ground area (including multipule tents)
- Demolition of part or whole structures

Building permits are **NOT** required for the following:

- Roof re-shingling
- Replacement of existing, same-size windows and doors, hot water tank, furnace
- Replacing exterior siding
- Minor Interior renovations such as replacing cabinetry
- Accessory shed under 15 sq.m (161 sq.ft.) but must conform to zoning

Non-Residential – Commercial Sector \$4.25/square foot

Smoke Alarms are mandatory in all homes, on every level of the home and outside all sleeping areas.


Carbon Monoxide Alarms are required in homes with a fossil-fuel burning appliance, wood stove or attached garage and must be located outside of all sleeping areas





All alarms have an expiry date of 7-10 years, depending on manufacturer recommendations. Be sure to check the expiry date when you change the alarm batteries to ensure your alarms are current.

Plan and practice your **Escape Plan**. Know 2 ways out of rooms. Have a set meeting place outside. Once you get out, Stay Out!



Burn Permits - Please be advised that OSM moved to an online burn permitting system effective January 1, 2023.

Owners of property in OSM, will need to create an account, and request the burn permit via the online system found at: osm.burnpermits.com

Clear Garbage Bag Program. We thank all residents for helping to make this program a continued success. The Township is very pleased to report that since the launch of the program there has been a significant decline in waste generation and a huge increase in recycling. Garbage can be left at the curb or can be taken to the Drummond Line Transfer Station for a fee in the following ways: 1) in a clear bag in a garbage container; 2) in a clear bag; or 3) in an opaque small grocery size privacy bag to shield private items. Garbage must be at the road before 7:00am to avoid missing collection. For clear bag program details please see the Township website www.osmtownship.ca.

- · Bagged recycling will not be collected.


